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A VOTER'S MANUAL OF THE PROS AND CONS PUBLIC EDUCATION FOR 4 INITIATIVES

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Public Education on “House Legislative Initiative 16-11 to Amend Article III, Section 9(a) of the Constitution”

Question: Do you approve of House Legislative Initiative 16-11 to amend Article III, Section 9(a) of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to prohibit the withdrawal of any funds from the General Fund except by appropriations made by law Article XV, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands? Yes or No.

Stated Findings: The Legislature finds that in the past decade the Legislature and the Governor failed to pass the budget for fiscal years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, and 2006, by the September 1 deadline. The Legislature also finds that the submission of the Governor’s proposed budget to the Legislature is on or before April 1 allowing sufficient time for members to reach an agreement by September 1, which provides the Legislature with five months to consider the budget. The failure to enact a budget has contributed to the Commonwealth Government’s cumulative deficit of approximately \$170 million, which is in violation of Article X, Section 6, of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, which requires that if an operating deficit is incurred in future fiscal years, that the government shall retire the deficit during the second consecutive fiscal year following the year.

The Legislature also finds that 23 U.S. states contain provisions to effectuate the shutdown of government services until a budget is enacted, further emphasizing the fiscal importance of enacting a budget. Thirty-seven states have provisions against carrying deficits into the next fiscal year, which further enforces the principle of a balanced budget. The Legislature additionally finds that in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the Commonwealth it is necessary that the government continue to provide essential services without interruption and effectuate the cessation of services that are not essential in a safe, effective, and orderly manner.

There are many costs associated with the failure to enact a budget including increased operational costs, the inability to deal with contractual obligations, and increased deficit spending resulting from working at the previous year’s spending levels. Other incalculable costs include the decline in public confidence in elected officials, damage to the image of the Commonwealth Government, and a poor credit rating.

General Summary: House Legislative Initiative 16-11’s priority is to ensure that on October 1, the beginning of each fiscal year, the legislator has passed a balanced budget. The House concludes that in the past not having a balanced budget at the beginning of the new fiscal year has caused the Commonwealth to spend outside its means until a balanced budget is finalized and passed. Accordingly, this initiative, attempts to ensure that both the Legislators and the Governor pass a balanced budget by October 1, by suspending their salaries if they do not meet their deadlines. If the Governor does not submit a “detailed and balanced budget” to

the Legislature by April 1, each year, then the Governor's salary will be suspended until a detailed and balanced budget is submitted. If the legislators do not submit and pass a balanced budget by October 1, each year, then their salaries will be suspended until they do so. If a balanced budget is not passed by October 1, then this initiative states that until a balanced budget is passed the only money that can be drawn from the general fund is for certain government services and employees whose services are "essential to the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the Commonwealth and to protect against damage to and destruction of property."

Pros:

1. This initiative puts pressure on the Legislature and the Governor during this economic crisis to create a balanced budget by October 1, each year.
2. The initiative holds the Legislature accountable, if they do not balance the budget by October 1, their pay will be suspended until a balanced budget is passed.
3. The initiative holds the Governor accountable, if the Governor does not submit a proposed detailed and balanced budget by April 1, the Governor's salary will be suspended.
4. This initiative ensures that the government will not spend money until it has created a budget so that it may spend within its means.

Cons:

1. The initiative states that if October 1 passes without a balanced budget, no non-essential money can be drawn from the general fund.
2. If a budget is not passed by October 1, all non-essential government workers may be put on austerity leave or have their salaries suspended until a budget is passed.
3. During a time of crisis, the government may need to spend money when a budget does not exist.
4. The salary suspensions that both the Legislators and the Governor face if a budget is not passed may force a budget through that is not in the best interest of the people in order that a budget is passed by the deadline so that the Governor and Legislators' salaries are not suspended.

Public Education on "Senate Legislative Initiative 16-11 to Amend Article VIII, Section 1 of the Constitution"

Question: Do you approve of Senate Legislative Initiative 16-11 to amend Article VIII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to hold regular general elections only in even-numbered years? Yes or No.

Stated Findings: With the implementation of US Public Law 110-229 granting the Commonwealth a non-voting delegate to the US Congress, the CNMI Government has to conduct a separate election for that office in even-numbered years commencing in 2008 in addition to holding regular general election in odd-numbered years pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1 of the CNMI Constitution. By

not holding an election every year, the Legislature finds that the cost-savings could be used for other programs and services in need of additional funds. Therefore, the purpose of this initiative is to propose an amendment as set forth in section 2 hereof to Article VIII, Section 1 of the CNMI Constitution to hold general elections only in even-numbered years.

General Summary: Senate Legislative Initiative 16-11 proposes to hold the general election and the election for the non-voting delegate during even-numbered years. This would eliminate the need for a special election like the one conducted in 2008 for the federal non-voting delegate position. Instead, the Commonwealth would vote for the federal non-voting delegate during the general election. The Senate has found that by holding one election instead of two a reported \$87,530.00 would be saved. This \$87,530.00 could then be used for other programs and services in the CNMI that are in need of additional funds. In the short term this initiative would affect the length of terms of the individuals that are voted into office in this 2009 election and during the next midterm election. All House of Representatives elected in November will serve a three-year term instead of the customary two-year term. All Senators elected in November will serve a five-year term instead of the customary four-year term. Likewise, the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Mayors will each serve a five-year term instead of the customary four-year term. The increased term length would only happen during this election in order to synchronize the general election and the election for the non-voting delegate in 2012.

Pros:

1. By eliminating the need for a special election every four years to elect the federal non-voting delegate, and instead moving the general election to even-numbered years, the CNMI would save a reported \$87,530.00.
2. By moving the general election to even-numbered years, the public will not be inundated almost yearly, with campaign pamphlets, posters and ads.
3. CNMI political parties will save money by not having two separate elections in which to campaign for candidates.

Cons:

1. If this initiative passes, then all House of Representatives elected in November 2009 will serve a three-year term, instead of the statutory two-year term.
2. If this initiative passes, all Senators elected in November, 2009 election will serve a five-year term instead of the statutory four-year term.
3. If this initiative passes all Mayors, and the Governor elected in November, 2009 will serve a five-year term instead of the statutory four-year term.

Public Education on “Open Government Act of 2007”

Question: Do you approve of the popular initiative entitled the “Open Government Act of 2007,” to amend 1 CMC §9913 to read as follows: “§9913. Legislative Branch: Applicability. The Commonwealth Legislature, including all Commonwealth legislators and the Legislative Bureau, shall be subject to 1 CMC §9901, et seq. The respective rules and procedures of the Senate, the House of Representatives, and the Legislative Bureau shall be in compliance with this Chapter.” Yes or No.

Proposed Purpose: “The people of the Commonwealth find and declare that they do not yield their sovereignty to the agencies which serve them. The people, in delegating authority, do not give their public servants the right to decide what is good for the people to know and what is not good for them to know. The people insist on remaining informed so that they may retain control over the instruments they have created. It is the intent of this Initiative Petition that the Commonwealth Legislature, including all Commonwealth legislators and the Legislative Bureau, shall be subject to Public Law 8-41, the Open Government Act, 1 CMC §§ 9901, et seq.

General Summary: If this initiative is approved, the Open Government Act outlined in Public Law 8-41 will apply to the Legislature. The Open Government Act ensures that the general public remains informed on the issues that their elected officials bring in front of the Legislature. All Legislative meetings are announced ahead of time, and final action is not taken unless the public has had a chance to comment on the measure.

- (1) The Legislature would have to give seventy-two hours (3 days) notice of its agenda to the general public. This notice is to be published in the media in order to allow the general public to make comments or attend meetings where issues that are important to them will be discussed.
- (2) During legislative meetings all “persons shall be permitted to attend any meeting of the governing body of a public agency.”
- (3) The legislature must afford all individuals an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, in writing on any agenda item.
- (4) No ordinance, rule, resolution, law, regulation, etc. may be adopted except in a meeting open to the public.
- (5) Final action may only be taken on an ordinance, rule, resolution, law, regulation, etc. at a meeting that has been fixed by law or rule or by which notice has been given in accordance with the Open Government Act (either 72-hour notice or if it is an emergency an emergency meeting can be called).
- (6) In times of emergency, a meeting may be called without needing to give 72 hours’ notice. However, the Legislature must “(a) state in writing the reasons for its finding that an emergency exists; (b) take a vote whereby two-thirds of all members to which the board is entitled

- agree that an emergency exists; (c) file an emergency agenda and the findings on emergency in official records of the governing bodies.”
- (7) Lastly, this initiative entitles the public to inspect within 10 days of a request all public records, unless specifically exempted within Section 19 of the law.

Pros:

1. By giving the public 72 hours' notice prior to a legislative meeting, the public will be more inclined and have more time to become informed on an issue and comment on the issue.
2. The general public's knowledge, understanding and participation in the legislative process will increase.
3. Accountability for elected officials will increase, as the public is made fully aware of all issues, discussions, and matters that are brought before the legislature.
4. The public will be able to request the minutes and documents from all legislative meetings unless it is specifically exempted under the act.
5. This initiative ensures that the Legislature's actions are open, public and that no final action can be taken without first giving notice to the public.

Cons:

1. The 72-hour notification might not account for issues taking longer than one day to decide. The Legislature will be unable to roll matters over to the next day if discussions become lengthy, instead the Legislature will have to provide another 72-hour notice.
2. If the Legislature mistakenly fails to give proper notice the act is null and void.
3. In times of emergency, it may be hard to call a meeting when two-thirds of the legislators are needed to state that the matter is an emergency and must be decided on immediately.
4. The necessity for giving notice to all legislative meetings, will decrease the likelihood that legislators will meet outside of committee members to discuss matters.
5. The legislators and their assistants' workload will increase.

Public Education on House Legislative Initiative 15-3

Question: Do you approve of House Legislative Initiative 15-3 to amend Article XV, Section 1(c) and (e) of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to one member being a high school student – one member selected by the teachers within the Public School System – the selection process of a public school teacher representative shall be established by law – the elected board members shall be limited to two terms – and the public elementary and secondary education system shall be guaranteed an annual budget of not less than 15 percent of the general revenues of the Commonwealth through an annual appropriation? Yes or No?

General Summary: If approved this initiative will reformat the board of education. Currently, the board of education is composed of five elected members that may serve unlimited terms and three non-voting members appointed by the Governor. The three non-voting members are (1) a public school student; (2) a representative of the nonpublic schools; (3) and a member to be selected by an exclusive bargaining representative of the teachers within the Department of Education Public School System. If this initiative is approved, then the five elected members will be limited to serving two terms. The non-voting public school student will be required to be a high school student. Lastly, Department of Education Public School System representative will be required to be a teacher. The selection process of the public school teacher will be established by law. As well, this initiative guarantees that the public elementary and secondary schools will receive an annual appropriation of 15 percent of the Commonwealth's general revenue.

Pros:

1. This initiative guarantees that the public elementary and secondary school will be allotted an annual budget of not less than 15 percent of the general revenues of the Commonwealth through an annual appropriation.
2. By limiting the terms of elected members it encourages the public to become more involved and encourages new ideas and voices to be heard.
3. Making the public school student representative a high-school student allows for the board to give this member extra responsibility and offer his or her youthful perspective on various school-related issues.
4. Ensuring that one member of the board is a public school teacher will assist the Board in developing personnel policies to attract and retain highly qualified teachers.

Cons:

1. Defining the public elementary and secondary schools' annual budget by 15 percent of the general revenues may not take into consideration the necessity of funds for other agencies or the true amount of money that is needed for the schools.
2. Limiting the amount of terms an elected member can serve may remove members who have vast experience and knowledge of the what needs to be done for the public school systems and how.
3. Requiring the Department of Education representative to be a teacher, may not take into consideration issues that a Public School administrator would want to address.
4. The initiative has not outlined a process by which the public school teacher is to be chosen for the board.
