

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

A Voter Registration Drive will be conducted on July 6, 2022 on Tinian at the listed location below:

• Tinian Mayor's Office – 9:30 am to 2:00 pm

A person is eligible to vote who, on November 8, 2022, is 18 years of age or older, is a domicile in the Commonwealth, has resided in the Commonwealth for 120 days prior to the day of the election, is not serving a sentence for a felony conviction, has not been declared by a court to be judicially insane, and is either a citizen or national of the United States as defined in the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution.

Previously registered voters who have failed to vote in the 2018 and 2020 General Election must re-register to be eligible to vote in the 2022 General Election. For first time voters, please provide a Valid US Passport or Birth Certificate.
