SENATE LEGISLATIVE INITIATIVE No. 17-12, HD1

A SENATE LEGISLATIVE INITIATIVE

To amend Section 2 (b) of Article XV of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to authorize the Board of Regents to revise the mission statement of the Northern Marianas College.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SEVENTEENTH NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. <u>Legislative Findings</u>. The Legislature finds that unlike most colleges in the United States, the mission statement of the Northern Marianas College is set forth in the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands. This prohibits the Northern Marianas College from revising its mission statement as necessary from time to time. The Legislature finds that effective organizations, especially post-secondary institutions, must evolve responsibly in order to continually improve and grow as a reflection of the communities that they serve.

The Legislature further finds that in order to comply with accreditation standards, the Northern Marianas College must have a mission statement that defines the institution's broad educational purposes, its intended student population, and its commitment to achieving student learning and the statement must be approved by the Board of Regents. Moreover, accreditation standards as well as best practices in higher education require that the mission statement of the Northern Marianas College be reviewed on a regular basis using the institution's governance and decision making processes and be revised when necessary. Accordingly, the purpose of this legislative initiative is to amend the Constitution of the Northern Marianas College to

identify and set the college's mission statement in order to assist the College conform to best practices in higher education and to accreditation standards. It further strengthens the college's autonomy.

Section 2. <u>Legislative Initiative</u>. The Seventeenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature, by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of each house present and voting, hereby amend Section 2 (b) Article XV of the Constitution of the Northern Marianas Islands to be placed before the people for ratification at the next general or special election:

"A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT:

To amend Section <u>2</u> (b) of Article XV of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to read as follows:

b) The mission purpose of the college shall be to provide the best quality and meaningful postsecondary and adult educational opportunities for the purpose of improving the quality of life for the individual and for the Commonwealth as a whole. The college shall be responsible for providing education in the areas of adult and continuing education, postsecondary and adult vocational education and professional development for the people of the Commonwealth. The board of regents shall establish the mission statement of the college."

Section 3. Adoption and Transmittal. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall certify, and the Senate Legislative Secretary and the House Clerk shall attest to the adoption of this Legislative Initiative. The Senate Clerk shall then transmit a certified copy of the Initiative to the Governor and the Board of Elections. Pursuant to Article XVIII, Section 5 of the Commonwealth Constitution, the Board shall place this Legislative Initiative, with the Findings and Purpose section herein, before the people of the Commonwealth for ratification vote at the earlier of the next regular general election or the next special election established by law.

Passed by the Senate on June 28, 2012 and the House of Representatives on May 15, 2012 by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members in each house.
